For three weeks, while showcasing Inwelle Centre and its supporters at its 10th anniversary, the Centre will engage in activities focused on attracting girls, especially indigent marginalized girls in our community to STEM and I.T. Careers. Throughout the three week event, Inwelle Centre Girls project in collaboration with organization outside Nigeria will be exhibited to the community. From November to December, **Purdue students will work co-operatively with Inwelle Centre to implement a solar energy solution. The effort will be filmed in virtual reality (VR) and showcased at the [Raw Science Film Festival](#) in December, 2015.** The proposed [Inwelle Centre](#) collaboration is through Raw Science TV partner [Global NGO Solutions](#) founded by Jo Anne Murphy with [Ambassador Sharon Wilkinson](#). Inwelle Centre girls who have been supported by Global Fund for Women to succeed in different fields of science and technology will hold town hall meetings, seminars, workshops. Experts from NGOs and the Academic community will present, participate, and facilitate sessions in a one-day conference aimed at attracting girls to the field of science and technology and changing mindset of stakeholders on girls and science technology field.
